Having completed a PGCert in Clinical Orthodontics in London he is now undertaking a masters degree in Birmingham in the same subject. With extensive experience in both fixed and clear aligner systems, he welcomes referrals for patients requiring routine or complex orthodontic care.

In addition to his orthodontic expertise, Ben has a strong interest in aesthetic dentistry and can incorporate treatments like composite bonding or whitening where appropriate, either delivering them himself or referring patients back to their own dentist following orthodontic treatment.

Orthodontic treatments available for referral:

Clear Aligner Therapy

- Invisalign and Spark systems
- Predictable outcomes using auxiliaries such as TADs, power arms, and elastics

Fixed Appliance Therapy

- Damon self-ligating system and conventional metal/ceramic braces
- Digitally guided bracket placement for precision

Complex & Multidisciplinary Cases

- Hybrid treatments (aligners + fixed appliances) for complex movement patterns
- Management of impacted or ectopic teeth
- Skeletal camouflage for mild to moderate skeletal discrepancies
- Collaborative planning with Georgia Barron for implant positioning, surgical exposure, or anchorage support using TADs
- Joint care with Lizzie Morris for periodontally stabilised patients, ensuring orthodontic treatment supports reduced periodontal structures

Example case

Before:

The patient presented unhappy with a deep bite and severe crowding. The lower left canine was severely lingually positioned.



During:

Ben treated the patient without extractions using Damon fixed braces in the lower arch and clear aligners in the upper.



After:

The case was finished with whitening, replacement of old composites on the upper centrals and retainers.

- Internal bleaching for discoloured teeth

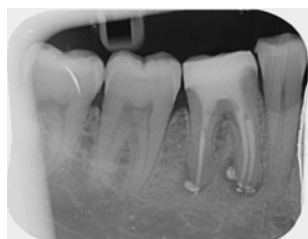
Case 1

This patient presented with apical pathology associated with an open apex and discolouration of the UL1 following trauma. Alex placed an apex plug using One Fill putty, followed by internal and external bleaching.



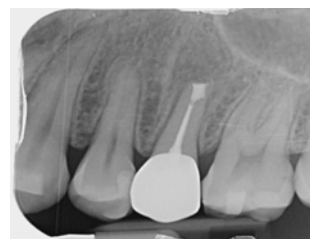
Case 2

Case 3

Apicectomy UL5 with healing at 6 month review.

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Oral Surgery, Sedation and Implants

Georgia joined Morris Dental Care in 2020 and has extensive experience in oral surgery, gained from multiple Oral and Maxillofacial Units and Specialty Dentist role in Oral Surgery at the University Dental Hospital of Manchester. Georgia completed her MSc in Dental Implantology in June 2025 at the University of Salford.

Georgia provides oral surgery, implants, and sedation services in a calm, patient-centered environment, and welcomes referrals from local practices for a wide range of procedures.

Surgical Treatments available for referral:

Surgical Extractions

- Complex and surgical extractions
- Removal of impacted teeth, including wisdom teeth
- Coronectomy of high-risk third molars

Orthodontic-Based Surgery

- Exposure of impacted teeth for orthodontic traction
- Placement of Temporary Anchorage Devices (TADs)

Dental Implant Treatment

- Single and full-arch implant placement and restoration including bone grafting

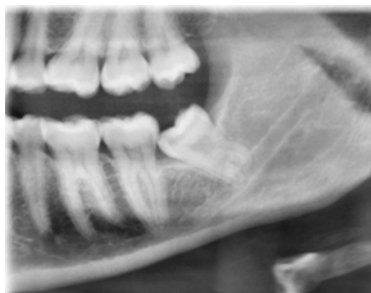
Sedation (Inhalation and IV)

- Available for all surgical procedures or to support restorative or hygiene treatments
- Suitable for anxious patients or those with a strong gag reflex

Morris Dental Care offers full on-site digital diagnostics, including CBCT and intraoral scanning, allowing complete planning without external referrals. Georgia also collaborates with Ben (Orthodontic Dentist) and Dean (Clinical Dental Technician) to ensure seamless care for complex cases.

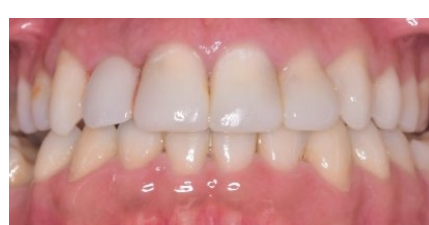
Case 1 - Coronectomy for nerve preservation

A patient with recurrent pericoronitis was found to have a lower third molar in close proximity to the inferior dental nerve. Georgia performed a coronectomy under local anaesthesia with IV sedation to reduce the risk of nerve injury. The patient is now pain-free and extremely satisfied with the result.



Case 2 - Implant placement following orthodontic space management

This patient was concerned about their reverse overbite and missing upper right lateral incisor. Ben used aligners to correct the bite and carefully maintain space for implant placement. Once alignment was complete, Georgia placed a dental implant to restore the missing tooth, achieving a natural and stable result.



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Periodontology

Periodontal treatments available for referral:

Non-Surgical Periodontal Therapy

- Tailored oral hygiene advice to improve patient motivation and compliance
- Supra and subgingival PMPR with individualised home care instruction

Surgical Periodontal Therapy

- Pocket reduction procedures, flap surgery, and access surgery for advanced cases

Regenerative Procedures

- Guided tissue regeneration and bone grafting for vertical bone defects
- Use of biologically active materials such as Emdogain®

Crown Lengthening

- Performed for aesthetic improvement or to aid restorative treatment of deep margins

Recession Coverage

- Root coverage procedures for Miller's Class I and II defects

Periodontal Maintenance

Case study

A 35-year-old patient was referred with persistent deep periodontal pockets around LR5 and LR6, unresponsive to prior non-surgical therapy. A periapical radiograph confirmed a vertical bone defect in this region.

Lizzie carried out a minimally interventive surgical approach using microsurgical techniques under the dental microscope. Treatment included:

- Bone grafting to regenerate lost bone structure
- Application of Emdogain® to support soft tissue regeneration and healing



Outcome:

Post-treatment radiographs show significant bone fill in the affected area. The regenerative procedure has led to a stable outcome, and the patient has shown great improvement in both bone support and clinical attachment levels.

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Complex Prosthodontics

Lizzie, with a Masters in Fixed and Removable Prosthodontics, has particular expertise in managing severe tooth wear and provides tailored full-mouth rehabilitations using both fixed and removable options.

Alex, whose clinical focus includes endodontics, supports cases where tooth wear has compromised internal tooth structure, helping to preserve vitality and ensure long-term outcomes.

Rehabilitation treatments available on referral:

Management of Severe Tooth Wear

- Minimally invasive functional and aesthetic restorations using composite or porcelain

Full-Mouth Rehabilitation

- Comprehensive treatment plans involving crowns, bridges, implants, and dentures

Complete and Partial Dentures

- Solutions for complex cases, including fibrous ridges, flat/negative ridges

Case 1 Treated by Lizzie

This patient required full-mouth rehabilitation at an increased occlusal vertical dimension (OVD). Treatment was completed in RCP using a combination of direct composite restorations, porcelain onlays and crowns, and tooth-supported overdentures. A comprehensive approach was taken to restore function, aesthetics, and long-term stability.



Case 2 Treated by Alex

This patient presented with significant anterior tooth surface loss due to acid erosion. Lithium disilicate veneers were placed on the upper anterior teeth to restore aesthetics and function at an increased occlusal vertical dimension (OVD). The case was carefully planned to ensure the preservation of remaining tooth structure.



Case 3

This patient struggled with poorly fitting dentures that lacked lip support and retention. We crafted realistic dentures with excellent suction on both the upper and lower arches, overcoming previous challenges from significant alveolar ridge loss.





Inhalation Sedation for Children
